The program fosters positive relationships between parents and children and offers strategies that help parents support their children's social-emotional development and healthy decision-making.

The training combines curriculum information with opportunities to explore the modules and practice delivery techniques. Parent educators expand their knowledge of experiential learning approaches, how to apply resilience and protective factor research to everyday parenting, and how to build parents' skills to help their children express feelings appropriately, use self-control, develop creativity, solve problems, make healthy choices, and be meaningfully involved in family life. Cancellations. A full refund will be issued for cancellations received 30 days or more before training date. For cancellations received less than 30 days and more than 7 days before training date, the training portion of the registration fee ("training fee") will be charged per cancelled participant and Wingspan will issue to the registering organization a maximum of two vouchers valid for one year, for participation in other Wingspan open enrollment training. For cancellations received 7 days or less before the training date, the full training fee will be forfeited, no voucher will be issued. Failure of a registered participant to attend training on the date scheduled or to sign and submit to Wingspan an Acknowledgment of Terms and Conditions will be considered a cancellation of less than 7 days notice and the full training fee will be charged. A participant registering for another training date without a voucher will be required to pay the full registration fee. A 10% restocking fee will be charged for materials not distributed due to failure of a registered participant to attend training, regardless of when any notice of cancellation is received. Wingspan reserves the right to cancel an open enrollment training due to insufficient enrollment. Open Enrollment Training

Following are the Terms and Conditions on which Wingspan will provide to Client Wingspan's proprietary program and materials (the "Program").

Use of Program and Program Materials. All Client personnel who sign and submit to Wingspan an Acknowledgment of and Agreement to Terms and Conditions ("Acknowledgment") and who complete the training conducted by Wingspan authorized trainers are authorized to use the Program in accordance with all specifications and requirements of the Program, as set forth in the Program manual and as otherwise communicated by Wingspan. No other persons are authorized to use any aspect of the Program or the associated materials. Client personnel who have completed the Wingspan training may not train other persons in the use of the Program.

Wingspan Intellectual Property. Wingspan grants to Client and its personnel who are authorized to use the Program a limited, nonexclusive, and nontransferable license to conduct the Program, distribute and display Wingspan's copyrighted program materials (the "Licensed Materials") and to use Wingspan's proprietary trademarks and service marks (the "Licensed Marks") solely in the course of and for the purpose of providing the Program in accordance herewith. The Licensed Materials, the Licensed Marks and all related know how and trade secrets are referred to collectively as the "Wingspan Intellectual Property." Wingspan reserves all rights to the Wingspan Intellectual Property not expressly licensed. Client acknowledges that Wingspan is the sole owner of the Wingspan Intellectual Property. Neither Client nor any of its employees or agents will (i) contest or challenge Wingspan's ownership or rights in the Wingspan Intellectual Property, (ii) make or authorize any use of the Wingspan Intellectual Property that is not consistent with these Terms and Conditions or (iii) modify or reproduce the content or substance of the Wingspan Intellectual Property. In the event of a violation by Client or any of its employees or agents of these Terms and Conditions, the license provided for herein will terminate immediately, in which case Client and its employees or agents will immediately cease all use of Wingspan Intellectual Property and return all program materials to Wingspan.

Cancellations. A full refund will be issued for cancellations received 30 days or more before training date. Miscellaneous. Client may not assign or transfer in any way any of its rights and obligations relating to the Program. These Terms and Conditions can be modified only in writing signed by both Client and Wingspan. Any matters relating to the Program or these Terms and Conditions are to be governed exclusively by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and any legal proceeding arising out of or relating thereto shall be brought exclusively in the federal or state courts whose jurisdiction and venue are in Richmond, Virginia, and Client and Wingspan each agree and submit to the personal jurisdiction and venue of any court therein. Client acknowledges that any violation of these Terms and Conditions may subject Wingspan to irreparable injury not fully compensable in monetary damages, and that Wingspan is entitled to seek whatever remedies are available to it at law or in equity, including but not limited to preliminary and permanent injunctive relief. Client further consents to court enforcement of the specific language of these Terms and Conditions.
